## **PAVILION RULES**

- Pavilion hours are from 5:00AM to 11:00PM daily (Midnight on Friday and Saturday)
- Alcohol is not permitted anywhere in the Park
- All trash is to be picked up and disposed of in the trash receptacles prior to leaving the Pavilion.
- No tent(s) are to be erected without prior approval of the Parks Director
- Beverages, food, or merchandise may not be sold without prior approval of the Park Director
- Bands and/or concerts must have prior approval of the Parks Director
- Reserving a Pavilion does not grant an exclusive use of any other park areas or playground equipment
- Any signs or decorations used on or around a Pavilion must be removed when leaving the Pavilion
- ■Fireworks and/or aerial fireworks are prohibited within the Park
- **■**Climbing on the Park Pavilions is prohibited
- All persons, groups, associations, and organizations, whether under permit, letter of permission or contract shall be bound by all park rules and regulations, as well as all applicable city ordinances fully as though the same were inserted in such permit, letter of permission or contact
- Unless stated to the contrary in a facility use contract, the person to whom a reservation, permit or letter of permission is issued shall be liable for any loss, damage to facilities, or injuries sustained by any person or persons for whatever reason, whether by accident or negligence during the permitted facility use period
